



## **KRAVIS CENTER FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS Public Ticket Sale Day Starts at 9 am on October 1 for Most Upcoming Concerts and Shows During Special Silver Anniversary Season**

(West Palm Beach, FL – September 2, 2016) The Public Ticket Sale Day for the 25th anniversary season of the **Raymond F. Kravis Center for the Performing Arts** will be Saturday, October 1.

The Dreyfoos Hall lobby will open at 7:30 am that day with breakfast treats and coffee. Starting at 8 am, **Jill and Rich** from Legends Radio will bring their sparkling banter and contest give-aways live to the festive event.

The outside box office windows will open at 9 am, when entertainment fans can purchase tickets for dozens of different shows, concerts and special events, including the Alvin Ailey American Dance Theater, The Beach Boys, Michael Bolton, Chris Botti, Capitol Steps, Kristin Chenoweth, Melissa Etheridge, Kenny G, Chaka Khan, Lang Lang, Steve Lawrence, Jay Leno, Orchestre National de Lyon, Itzhak Perlman, Philadelphia Orchestra, Pink Martini Featuring China Forbes, Pokémon: Symphonic Evolutions, Smokey Robinson, The Four Tops and The Temptations, Twyla Tharp and more.

Tickets for several different series at the Kravis Center will go on sale on later dates: October 22 for the *Young Artists Series*, November 19 for the *Adults at Leisure Series*, and January 20 for the three concerts under the banner of *Michael Feinstein Conducts The Kravis Center Pops Orchestra*.

Individual tickets for three of this year's popular *Kravis on Broadway* series (*THE CURIOUS INCIDENT OF THE DOG IN THE NIGHT-TIME*, *AN AMERICAN IN PARIS* and *DIRTY DANCING – THE CLASSIC STORY ON STAGE*) went on sale on August 27, while tickets for the four remaining shows in the series (*BEAUTIFUL - THE CAROLE KING MUSICAL*, *THE PHANTOM OF THE OPERA*, *KINKY BOOTS* and *THE SOUND OF MUSIC*) will go on public sale in December.
